The Color Mix 250 is aimed at theatres, TV studios, stage lighting and interior and exterior architectural lighting.
3) ColorMix 150 AT wash is a PC washlight. It's colour wheel offers 11 dichroic slots plus open, and it has a dimmer shutter. It uses a 150 Watt CDM lightsource from Phillips which is mega bright. It's a static luminaire and can be either floor or ceiling mounted.



4) ColorMix 150 AT profile is the profile version of the Color Changer 150 AT, with all the same features plus an additional effect wheel offering gobos, beam reducers and another colour slots for mixing with filters on colour wheel.

The AT range is diverse and varied, thought-out from the outset as a whole family of fixtures, enabling designers and operators to 'mix-and-match' fixtures accordingly - without breaking the budget! Robe has an long reputation for producing, robust, reliable well engineered products.
